



Responsibilities of BC Curling Clubs Nominating Participants to the International Tankard

An International Tankard participant is a curling club member whose volunteer efforts have furthered the sport of curling and has been nominated by the curling club to participate in the events of the International Tankard.

Responsibilities of Nominating Curling Clubs are:

- * Curling Facility must be a current member of CurlIBC and located in Regions 8, 9, 10 or 11.
- * Participants of the International Tankard are nominated by their Curling Club (Centre/Facility) by whatever method they wish to do so. (Board of Directors and/or Manager).
- * Curling Facility should submit their nominee to the Region 11 International Tankard Committee by the deadline date of the current poster.
- * Submit to CurlIBC Region 11 Treasurer a registration fee of \$100.00.
- * Nominees are registered with the Region 11 Committee on a first come and first served basis and will be followed by confirmation from the Region 11 Committee. (Note: there are 24 positions available).
- * Provide three club pins to your nominee for exchange with their opposition counterparts and possibly three more pins for exchange with team mates at the event.
- * Curling Clubs may choose to provide some expense money to their nominee (ie hotel room or gas).
